Umapathi Gajanan Bhat 'Kirloskar Vasundhara Sanman 2025'

Shri Umapathi Gajanan Bhat is a dedicated environmental activist and educator. Over the past 25 years, he has worked tirelessly in service of the environment. Mr. Bhat has planted over 8,000 saplings and established 140 "Navagraha Vanas" and several specialised Vanas across Karnataka. He has prepared the next generation to become environmental stewards through workshops and lectures. Mr. Bhat has authored 10 ecological books including "Kevala Jnana Vrukshagalu" and "Nisarga Yaana", and widely documented biodiversity. His work has been recognised by the state level award "Salu Marada Thimmakka" Hasiru Puraskara in 2015. In appreciation of his efforts to protect the environment, raise awareness, and ensure nature thrives, we are proud to bestow upon Shri Umapathi Gajanan Bhat the honour of 'Kirloskar Vasundhara Sanman'.

While many people run away from snakes, Shri Venugopal Naidu runs towards them! For the last 34 years, Mr. Naidu, an agriculturist and passionate environmentalist, has been at the forefront of rescuing snakes. In addition to running the "Animal Protection" program on his own initiative, he has conducted many programmes in collaboration with private organisations and various departments, including the Forest Department. He assists veterinarians in treating severely injured animals. Mr. Naidu has been involved in tireless efforts to raise awareness about snakes. He visits schools and colleges to talk about the misunderstood reptile's importance in the ecosystem. His love for animals extends to stray dogs, going out of his way to treat injuries at his own expense. Shri Venugopal Naidu's compassion for all animals is commendable, and an inspiration for us all.
